THE JOB INVOLVES ...

Stock Management

- Ensure integrity and accuracy of the stock management system, including accurate purchase and retail costs, stock levels and stock information. Addressing inaccuracies including duplicate stock items, negative stock and incorrect prices promptly.
- Conduct on-going maintenance of Vector including correcting margins & conducting mini-stock takes
- Monitor and achieve target margins weekly through ensuring all stock on vector is accurate and all lines are delivering correct returns.
- Conduct monthly and cyclical stock takes, as requested, ensuring the accuracy of stock levels on Vector.
- Ensuring all internal transfers including staff kitchen / deli and waste are completed on Vector by closing on Sunday each week.
- Accurately setting up new stock items on Vector. Ensuring promotions are accurate at the point of sale.
- Regular and clear communication with the Buyer / IT manager and other Stock Controllers within the organisation.
- Reporting to the Buyer / IT manager regarding EPoS management and development.

Goods Received & Ordering

- Process purchase orders on Vector, reconciling delivery notes and invoices with purchase orders, updating costs where necessary.
- Accurately processing supplier paperwork including completing the goods in stamp, writing on department and ticking off/ signing invoices to communicate that the items have been checked.
 Ensuring that supplier paperwork is forwarded to the finance team.
- Ensuring correct documents are received, including invoices and costs updated on Vector.
- Ensuring the swift movement of stock, to enable high availability for customers.
- Accurately processing stock transfers between stores.
- Receiving deliveries, ensuring goods delivered match with paperwork and any discrepancies are followed up.
- Ensuring supplier returns are collected promptly and credits are arranged with suppliers within 24 hours of delivery, to minimise the financial loss to the company.
- Delegating to and training others on goods in procedures including use of the Vector system.
